Skills challenges

- Education offer ≠ business needs
- Lack of highly qualified and skilled workforce
- Lack of cooperation between businesses, education and government
- Difficult to forecast future skills needs and new occupational profiles
- Lack of recognition of qualifications bottleneck for mobility
- Lack of awareness about career opportunities


Expected outputs:

Blue Careers in Europe call 2018

Budget: €5 600 000 Closed on 31.01.2019 35 applications – 8 received funding

- Bringing together business and education
- Based on labour market needs analysis
- Addressing one of the following:
 - entrepreneurial skills
 - Structured collaboration between industry and education/training
 - "skills ecosystems" at sea basin level
- Visibility of blue careers and improved ocean literacy



Blue Careers in Europe call 2018 - 8 projects received funding

- ScienceDIVER: Cross-sectoral skills for the Blue Economy labour market
- BAPSI: Tagging fishing gears and enhancing on board best-practices to promote waste free fisheries
- CTP: Catching the Potential Setting the Standard for Sustainable Fishing Training
- MarLEM: Maritime Logistics Engineering and Management
- Sea of Experience: Establishment of Eastern Mediterranean Regional Network: pooling, sharing, development of innovative face-to-face and digital training/mentoring tools for the maritime sector
- MarENet: Atlantic Maritime Ecosystem Network
- NAUTILUS: Education & Certification Framework for Blue Career in Water Sports Tourism
- TEAMS: Teaching Entrepreneurship Advancing the Maritime Sector
